INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:



1 Separate a section of hair to be straightened.



3 Hold the hair firmly and brush down from root to tip.



2 Place Simply Straight[™] close to the roots of selected hair.

Repeat steps 1-3 for each length of hair until the desired area is straightened.

Allow the hair to cool down before applying styling product.
After use, press the "On/Off" button to turn "Off", then unplug your Simply StraightTM. Wait until Simply StraightTM is completely cooled down before handling or storing.

NOTE: Place the product as shown in step 2. Use Simply Straight[™] slowly and carefully to avoid contact with skin or scalp. Always use caution when using your free hand near Simply Straight[™].

TEMPERATURE SETTINGS:

When powered "On" and heating up, Simply Straight™ will display the rise in temperature on the LCD display until the desired temperature is reached.

To change between Centigrade to Fahrenheit, press "+" and "-" at the same time. The LCD display will immediately change units.

AUTO SHUT OFF:

Your Simply Straight[™] has an automatic safety shut off feature. If the unit is not used for more than 60 minutes continuously, it will automatically switch off. If you wish to continue using the unit after this has happened, press the "On/Off" button back to "On".

STORAGE:

When not in use, your Simply Straight[™] is easy to store. Please be sure Simply Straight[™] is cooled down completely before storage. Store in a cool, dry place. Keep out of reach of children. Do not jerk or strain cord at plug connections.

CLEANING:

Never run Simply Straight[™] under water or submerge in water. Unplug Simply Straight[™] and allow to cool down before cleaning. Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe away residue or dust. A lightly damp cloth may be used with caution.


